Introduction

This survey could be used to evaluate a pastor or a teacher or a church without them ever seeing it. Simply go through their teachings from their website or YouTube channel and mark the answers according to what you find.

Another way to use this survey is to give it to the pastor or teacher and ask them to complete it according to what they believe, practice, and teach. Give him a reasonable time frame in which to complete it. If he agrees and asks for another week, allow it. If he asks for yet another week, consent. But if after that he continues asking for more time to complete it you have your answer. He does not consider these matters important. For if he had then he would have known the answers to these questions for himself as a leader and could have readily completed it in a matter of 10 minutes. You can move on to another at that point and mark him off.

Every question here is of great importance. There are other important issues as well, but these are the issues that will weed out nearly all false teachers today.
